### Quality Improvement

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I understand and fully appreciate the importance of quality improvement in the modern health system.

1. **Notes audit for Trauma and Orthopedics**  
Completing the 'audit cycle' – reviewing the performance of the trauma and elective wards, following changes suggested from the previous audit presentation. 11/2010
2. **Medical record keeping standards in surgical inpatients** 02/2011  
Recognized need for audit in surgical note keeping. Results showed that note keeping was substandard compared to the Royal College of Physicians standards and that improvements were needed in clerking details. Audit cycle completed, highlighting improvements in standards. *Presented at Surgical Grand Rounds.*
3. **Alert Label Audit** 04/2011  
Asked to research the use of Alert Labels in patient notes. Discovered that their utilization was extremely poor and that medical staff rarely completed them adequately.
4. **Skin Cancer Audit** 03/2012
