Dr. Dan Herron's One-on-One with Dr. Dana Telem



Three SAGES Members Awarded COVID-19 Research Grants

SAGES Research & Career Development Committee awarded \$15k COVID-19 research grants to Dr. Caroline Reinke, Dr. Dennis Hong and Dr. Gretchen Jackson.

Research topics include the impact of COVID-19 on common non-elective general surgery diagnoses; impact of COVID-19 on



hospital lockdown, surgical outcomes and practice; and, SARS-CoV-2 detection in aerosolized emissions during minimally invasive surgery.
