This year, SAGES will live stream ONLY the main session room highlights on Thursday and Friday. This includes the two keynotes, the presidential address, and the presidential plenary and regular plenary sessions. The rest of the meeting content will be captured and posted online for the virtual meeting 8 weeks following the Montreal meeting. Virtual meeting attendees will have access to the very limited live streamed sessions, and all attendees will have access to the entire meeting content after the fact.

Margrét Oddsdóttir, MD Traveling Fellowship Award Application

Application deadline: Monday, February 13, 2023

SAGES Foundation is now accepting applications for the Oddsdottir Traveling Fellowship. This award honors Professor Margret Oddsdöttir, who was an international pioneer in laparoscopic surgery and a beloved member of the SAGES family. It is intended to help develop the next generation of minimally invasive surgeons, and will be awarded to a woman surgeon from a low/middle income country and her chosen research or clinical team member to attend the SAGES meeting.

The award includes registration for the two-person team as well as reimbursement up to \$5,000 to offset the cost of travel and hotel for the awardee and team member. Awardees will be invited to attend the SAGES Awards luncheon where the applicant will accept the award and make a 2-minute acceptance speech. The team will be seated at a table with SAGES leaders to foster a networking experience. For more information, please go here.

Don't Miss the Chance to Invest in the Future of Medicine with the SINC Opportunity Fund 1

Don't miss out! SAGES is targeting a \$2.5 million fund to invest in five to eight innovative start-ups in the therapeutic GI / GI surgery space, with alternative opportunities outside of GI to diversify the portfolio.



The SINC Opportunity Fund 1, in partnership with Varia Ventures, is structured to make venture investing more accessible by setting the minimum commitment at \$10,000 paid upfront (rather than \$250,000 to \$1 million typically required by funds). SAGES is very excited to be able to offer this investment prospect, and encourages participants to review this opportunity with their personal financial advisor. SAGES Liver Ablation Guidelines Available for Public Comment

The SAGES Guidelines Committee has completed the SAGES/AHPBA Guidelines for the Use of Microwave and Radiofrequency Liver Ablation for the Surgical Treatment of Hepatocellular Carcinoma or Colorectal Liver Metastases less than 5cm. This document was prepared and revised by the SAGES Guidelines Committee and surgeons from the Americas Hepato-Pancreato-Biliary Association (AHPBA). This document has been reviewed and approved by the SAGES Board of Governors and has been submitted to the AHPBA Executive Committee.

The document is now available for public review and comment by SAGES members before submitting it for publication. You will need to log in to your SAGES membership account to access the content and comment form. Please provide all comments by December 11 here.
